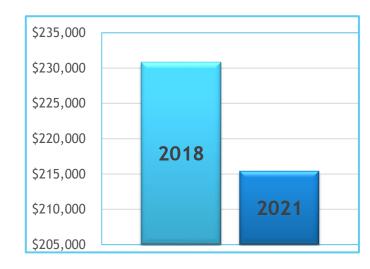

### **2021 Guiding Principles**

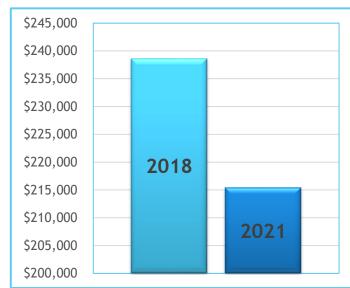
- ► THIS IS A BALANCED BUDGET (Requires using 2020 surplus funds)
  - > \$31,462 Surplus in 2020
    - > \$22,214 used to balance 2021 budget
    - > \$9,248 transferred to restricted Capital Reserve Account
- 2020 SURPLUS FUNDS are mostly from:
  - Minister Expenses
  - PPP Grant/loan
  - Operations costs
  - Music (Music Gift to community not held)
- SPECIAL FUNDRAISING FOR 2021 WILL BE 50% OF RECENT BUDGETS
- COVID-19 WILL CONTINUE THROUGH THE END OF SEPTEMBER (conservative assumption)
  - ▶ INVEST IN AREAS THAT WILL SUSTAIN AND BUILD THE MINISTRY OF THE CHURCH
  - SCALE BACK WHERE ACTIVITY IS REDUCED DUE TO COVID-19
  - ► ASSUME SPECIAL FUNDRAISING WILL BE 50% OF PREVIOUS BUDGETS

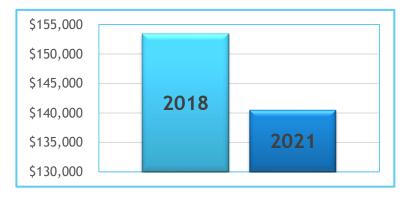

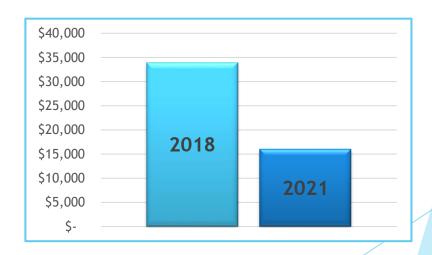

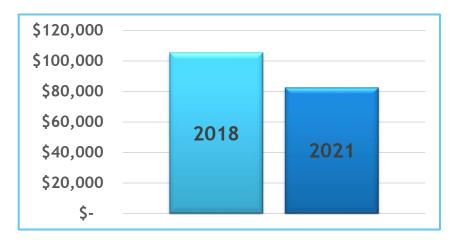
- ► SURPLUS 2020 INCOME REQUIRED TO BALANCE BUDGET \$22,214

### EXPENSES Minister, Music, Faith Formation

- The Church voted to hire a part-time pastor; the Call Agreement plus expenses total Minister: \$82,600
- The Organist will also assist with music coordination and a volunteer worship team until a Music Director is hired in October (post COVID)
- Its our intent to reinvest in the music program when it becomes wise to do so (when it's safe and its what we can afford) Total Music: \$10,575
- Based on December conversations we've broadened Family Ministry to Faith Formation to expand beyond working with families
- New responsibilities and a slight decrease in salary for Faith Formation staff Total Faith Formation: \$15,250
- TOTAL Minister, Music & Faith Formation: \$108,426

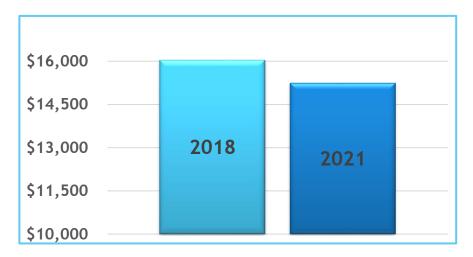
## EXPENSES Minister, Music, Faith Formation

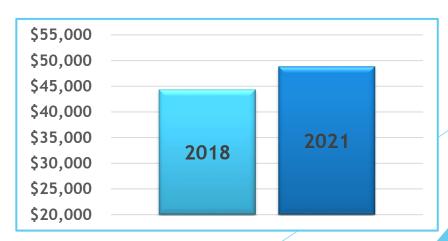
**Music Expenses**

## **EXPENSES**Operations

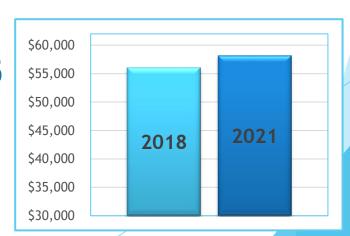
- Maintains funding for Administrative Assistant and Bookkeeper services (approved at 2020 Annual Meeting)
- Sexton position is reduced to coincide with work time needed during COVID-19 reflecting reduced use of church facilities (Feb 1-Sept 30)
- Bookkeeper, required church audit costs and property appraisal costs needed for property insurance are included in Professional Services
- Remaining Operations costs are in line with previous years budgets
- ▶ We are always looking for ways to save funds and reduce operations costs
- ► Total Operations: \$48,853



#### PROPERTY AND OTHER EXPENSES

- While the property insurance deductible was increased to save premium costs, nation-wide claims have resulted in a nearly \$4,000 increase in the property insurance premium.
- The second installment of parsonage property tax was paid in the 2020 budget resulting in a 50% reduction in tax for 2021.
- The remaining Property Expenses are in line with previous years budgets.
- Other and Wider Expenses are also in line with previous years budgets.
- ► Total Property and Other Expenses: \$58,535

#### **FUTURE CAPITAL NEEDS**

- ► The Church needs to be repainted & the sanctuary roof needs new gutters and downspouts.
- Water damage in the rear of the church needs to be repaired prior to painting.
- ▶ We may need to replace the church organ in the near future.
- Continued ownership of the parsonage will require continued repair/capital investment.
- Should the church further pursue sale of the parsonage, there will need to be funds set aside for legal, etc., costs.
