- Ukrainian Students at Woodstock Academy Discussed FCCW's role in helping Ukrainian students who are enrolled at Woodstock Academy:
 - ➤ Pulling our congregation, other congregations, and other community groups together to create a community of support for these students (Administrators at The Academy expressed that they would love to see if we could pull community together for some type of traditional Ukrainian meal
 - Maintaining and growing the volunteer database of those in the community who have talents that are needed to support the students. Reaching out to volunteers when needed. Continuing to reach out to church and community organizations to see if their members can add to the volunteer database.
 - Current & immediate needs are for tutors and summer housing
- Basket of Hope collected \$170 for Heifer International to purchase a Basket of Hope which includes 1 sheep (\$120), a flock of chicks (\$20), and flock of ducks (\$20).
- Green Congregation Challenge/Intergenerational Workshop Service on April 24th Outreach
 will participate in service with a booth promoting specific actions that can be taken by our
 members to help support the SNEUCC Green Congregation Challenge
- Faith in Action article We continue to ask members of the congregation to submit "Faith in Action" articles. The Faith in Action articles focus on members of our congregation that are passionate about and volunteer their time to a cause or organization (outside of FCCW). Goal is to inform and inspire others.
