## First Congregational Church of Woodstock Operating Fund Financial Comments – Year to Date March 2023

### Summary

 Operating net expenses were \$10k compared to \$11k net expenses budgeted, so \$1k better than budget. Operating income was on budget and operating expenses were \$1k lower than budget.

### Income

- Contributions income is \$1k better than budget. Thank you!
- We recognized \$10k of 2023 prepaid pledges as income in Jan-Mar. The remaining \$29k is shown on the Statement of Financial Position as Deferred Income Prepaid Pledges.
- There has been a delay in Tiny Forest Childcare LLC starting to use our nursery. We look forward to their completing all the required approvals and starting operation soon.
- Unrestricted investment income will pick up in May when the first of our recent investments in CDs will mature. See the separate comments for the Designated, Investment, Endowment & Restricted Funds for details.

### **Expenses**

- In the Facilities section, we had \$2,800 of unexpected costs in March to repair our boiler. The bills would have been considerably higher but for much donated labor courtesy of Glenn Boies and his company Deep 6 Plumbing & Heating. Thank you Glenn!
- Staff pay increases applied to work performed commencing February 1st so compensation for January was still at 2022 rates. Similarly, the amount and mix of the pastor's compensation and benefits changed on February 1st. The pastor's housing allowance and other elements of compensation and benefits for January 2023 were paid in accordance with the 2022 budget approved by the congregation.

You make possible our worship and pastoral care and enable us to serve people in need during these challenging times.

# First Congregational Church of Woodstock Designated, Investment, Endowment & Restricted Funds Financial Comments – Year to Date March 2023

### <u>Unrestricted Investments</u>

We increased our investment of operating funds in CDs to \$56k. We have built a ladder
of CDs that will generate income while still giving us access to additional funds within a
reasonable time if needed. We intend to hold CDs to maturity to reduce investment
risks.

### Congregation-Designated Reserve Funds

• We purchased \$30k of CDs using congregation-designated reserve funds. Income will be credited to each congregation-designated fund pro-rata.

### **Endowment (New Century) Fund**

• The market value of this fund is up by \$5k for January and February combined, recovering some of the drop we experienced last year. We report on this activity one month in arrears due to the time it takes to receive statements.

### **Donor-Designated Restricted Funds**

- We purchased \$50k of CDs using donor-restricted funds. Income will be credited to each donor-restricted fund pro-rata.
- You contributed \$435 to the Deacons Fund for Easter flowers. After paying the nursery in April the net proceeds will support future benevolence assistance from the Deacons Fund.
- You contributed \$384 in March to the UCC's special offering One Great Hour of Sharing.
   Along with more recent contributions this will be sent to the UCC in April.
- After discussions among the pastor and deacons we have revised our plans for the use
  of the \$1,000 set aside to assist Ukrainian students at the Woodstock Academy. Most
  will be returning to Ukraine at the end of the semester. We have put the funds to work
  providing assistance with specific personal needs of students who face financial
  hardship.

We continue to warmly welcome gifts to our main ministry, Angel and Endowment (New Century) funds while we work to reduce the number of funds for which extra administrative work is required.
